ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On June 5, 1990, the Commission issued its Report And Order certifying Gateway Long Distance Services, Inc. (Gateway) as an intrastate reseller of competitive interexchange services and authorizing Gateway to submit its tariff for such services.

On June 8, 1990, Gateway submitted its proposed tariff. On June 22, 1990, the Commission Staff recommended that the Commission approve the tariff for service rendered on or after July 8, 1990.


Having considered the proposed tariff and Staff's recommendation, the Commission has determined that the tariff is reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That tariff sheet P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 of Gateway Long Distance Services, Inc., is hereby approved for service rendered on and after July 8, 1990.
2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
