**ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

On February 14, 1996, the Commission issued an order which granted a certificate of convenience and necessity to S.T. Ventures, L.L.C., a Missouri Limited Liability Company (S.T. Ventures). In the order, the Commission directed S.T. Ventures to file a complete tariff consistent with the findings of the order.

On February 22, 1996, S.T. Ventures filed a complete tariff to provide sewer service to Smoke Tree Hills, a subdivision located in Taney County, Missouri.

On February 26, 1996, the Commission's Staff filed a memorandum to the official case file. In its memorandum, the Staff recommends approval of the tariff submitted by the company to become effective March 4, 1996. Staff states that the tariff was drafted using the Water and Sewer Department's example tariff for sewer utilities and that the language in the tariff is substantially the same as the language found in other sewer utility tariffs previously approved by the Commission. Staff states that in its opinion the tariff is in compliance with the Commission's order.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff and Staff's memorandum. The Commission finds that the tariff should be approved because it complies with the Commission's order.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**


