ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

This docket was reopened by the Commission order issued October 8, 1993, in response to a motion by Staff. The docket was reopened to consider the granting of an additional waiver to the city of Hermann of 4 CSR 240-40.030(7)(K)1., which corresponds to Federal Pipeline Safety Regulations 49 C.F.R. Part 192 §21(a). This rule requires that plastic pipe must be installed below ground level. The Commission had granted an original waiver of this rule for a temporary installation while a permanent steel line was installed. The docket was closed when the permanent line was completed.


Subsequent to the initial waiver, flooding again damaged the permanent natural gas pipeline. The Commission granted a waiver for another temporary plastic polyethylene pipe which was needed to provide service while the permanent steel pipe was being installed. Staff now indicates the permanent line is in place and in full operation. Since the permanent line has been installed and the temporary polyethylene pipe removed, the Commission will close this docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That this docket is hereby closed.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
