## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND MAKING TELIGENT, INC. A PARTY

On October 3, 2002, American Long Lines, Inc. filed an application asking the Commission to approve the transfer of assets and control of American Long Lines, Inc. from Teligent, Inc. to a new ownership group, comprised of the employees of American Long Lines, Inc. The new ownership group has purchased American Long Lines, Inc. from Teligent in a series of transactions arising out of Teligent's bankruptcy. American Long Lines, Inc., now asks the Commission to either approve that transaction, or issue an order finding that it does not have jurisdiction.

Although Teligent is a party to the transaction for which American Long Lines, Inc. seeks approval, it did not join in the application. The Commission will add Teligent as a party to this case.

The Commission finds that proper persons should be allowed an opportunity to intervene. Notice of this application will be sent to all interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies.
