FILE A REPORT

Daniel E. Brown filed a formal complaint against The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") on June 4, 2008.¹ Empire filed its answer to the complaint on July 7.

In a prior order the Commission directed its Staff to conduct an investigation into the complaint and file a report no later than three weeks following the filing of Empire's answer; however, this order did not provide a date certain for the filing of Staff's report.² The Commission will direct its Staff to file its report no later than July 21.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a report concerning the results of its investigation no later than July 21, 2008.
