**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME, IN PART**

Effective Date: October 31, 2008

On August 28, 2008, the Commission approved a Unanimous Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Sewer Company Revenue Increase Request entered into by the parties. The Agreement states that the Company will file tariff changes by September 30, 2008, updating the tariff language for its collecting sewer extension rule. On that date Aqua Missouri filed its revised tariff, designated Tariff File No. YS-2009-0227, to comply with the Agreement. The tariff bears an effective date of November 14, 2008.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion for extension of time stating that it has a meeting with personnel of Aqua Missouri, Inc., on November 3, 2008, and therefore, Staff is requesting until November 6, 2008, to file its recommendation. As Staff is aware, in order to give sufficient time for Commission consideration and an appropriate effective date, the Commission must consider any motion to suspend the tariff, if one should be filed, on its November 6, 2008 Agenda. Therefore, the Commission shall grant an extension of time to file the recommendation, but cannot allow until November 6, 2008.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file its recommendation regarding Aqua Missouri, Inc.'s tariff revision, Tariff File No. YS-2009-0227, as soon as possible and no later than November 5, 2008, at 4:00 p.m.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
