SOUTHWESTERN BELL WIRELESS'S STATEMENT OF POSITION

Pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission's August 10, 1999 Order Establishing Procedural Schedule, Southwestern Bell Wireless respectfully submits its Statement of Position:

1. <u>Is the tariff proposed by MMG lawful as applied to wireless or CLEC traffic?</u>

SWBW POSITION: No. The tariff change proposed by MMG is not lawful as applied to wireless traffic. By law, negotiated, reciprocal compensation rates apply to the exchange of traffic with wireless carriers, where such traffic originates and terminates within the same Major Trading Area (intraMTA traffic). The tariff change proposed by MMG is unlawful because it would apply access charges to intraMTA traffic exchanged with wireless carriers.

SWBW does not take a position of the issue of whether the tariff proposed by MMG is lawful as applied to CLEC traffic.

2. <u>If lawful, should the tariff proposed by MMG be approved?</u>

SWBW POSITION: The Commission should reject MMG's proposed tariff change on the basis that it is not lawful.
