**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF**

On June 9, 2008<sup>1</sup>, WPC Sewer Company (hereafter WPC Sewer) filed a rate increase request letter. WPC Sewer asked the Commission to allow it to increase its rates by \$19,207.56.

On November 6, the Staff of the Commission (hereafter "Staff") filed an *Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request*. The Agreement was between Staff and WPC Sewer only, and it stated that those parties agreed WPC Sewer should be allowed to increase its rates \$5,357. WPC Sewer also filed a tariff bearing an effective date of December 22 to effectuate that increase.

On December 9, the Office of the Public Counsel (hereafter "OPC") filed a request for a local public hearing. The Commission set a local public hearing, and suspended the tariff until January 21, 2009, to allow time for parties to comment after the hearing.

The local public hearing is set for January 5, 2009. Per Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050(19), Staff has five working days after the hearing, and OPC has ten working days after the hearing, to file pleadings regarding the disposition agreement. Because of

holidays in January, 2009, ten working days from January 5 is January 21, which is the day the current suspension of the tariff in this case ends. Therefore, the Commission will further suspend the tariff to allow it to review Staff's and OPC's pleadings.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. That the following tariff sheet filed by WPC Sewer Company, and assigned Tariff File No. YS-2009-0334, is suspended until February 4, 2009, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission:
