ORDER DENYING APPLICATION FOR REHEARING

On October 1, 2014, the Commission issued a report and order regarding a complaint brought by Noranda Aluminum and other individual customers against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, asking the Commission to reduce the rate Ameren Missouri is allowed to charge its customers. The Commission's report and order, which became effective on October 31, denied and dismissed that complaint. AARP. the Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Retailers Association, Noranda Aluminum, Inc., the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the Office of the Public Counsel filed a timely application for rehearing.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." AARP, the Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Retailers Association, Noranda Aluminum, Inc., the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the Office of the Public

Counsel have not shown sufficient reason to rehear the report and order. The Commission will deny their application for rehearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application for Rehearing or Reconsideration of AARP, the Consumers Council of Missouri, the Missouri Retailers Association, Noranda Aluminum, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the Office of the Public Counsel is denied.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
