On June 26, 2014¹, the Office of the Public Counsel filed its Position Statements and Notices of Agreement (“Notices”). The Notices stated that OPC objected to underlying disposition agreements between the companies and Staff. But they also stated that OPC believed the parties had resolved their disputes, and that a new agreement would be forthcoming.

The Commission has not received a new agreement, and the tariffs that would implement the original disposition agreements between the companies and Staff become effective on August 10. Thus, the Commission will order OPC and Staff to update the Commission on the status of these cases.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than July 25, 2014, the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel shall file a pleading as directed above.
