#### SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

#### 3.1 <u>Computation of Charges</u>

3.1.1 The total charge for each completed call may be a variable measured charge dependent on the duration, distance and time of day of the call. The total charge for each completed call may also be a fixed charge dependent only on the duration of the call, *i.e.* a statewide flat rate per minute charge. The variable measured charge is specified as a rate per minute which is applied to each minute. All 800/888 service calls and 1+Dialing calls are measured in six (6) second initial and six (6) second additional increments. All Prepaid Local Access Number Cards, 800 Debit Cards, Postpaid Calling Cards, and Rechargeable Calling Cards calls are measured in one (1) minute increments. All calls are rounded up to the next whole increment.

- 3.1.2 Where mileage bands appear in a rate table, rates for all calls are based upon the airline distance between the originating and terminating points of the call, as determined by the vertical and horizontal coordinates associated with the exchange (the area code and three digit central office code) associated with the originated and terminating numbers. If the Customer obtains access to the Company's network by a dedicated access circuit, that circuit will be assigned an exchange for rating purposes based upon the Customer's main telephone number at the location where the dedicated access circuit terminates. The vertical and horizontal (V & H) coordinates for each exchange and the airline distance between them will be determined according to the V&H Coordinate table contained in AT&T's FCC Tariff No. 10 which is incorporated herein by reference.
- 3.1.3 Timing begins when the called station is answered and two way communication is possible, as determined by standard industry methods generally in use for ascertaining answer, including hardware answer supervision in which the local telephone company sends a signal to the switch or the software utilizing audio tone detection. Recognition of answer supervision is the responsibility of the Underlying Carrier. Timing for each call ends when either party hangs up. The Company will not bill for uncompleted calls.

# 3.5.1 Prepaid Local Access Number Cards and 800 Debit Cards (cont'd)

Certain calls may not be completed using the Company's Prepaid Local Access Number Cards or 800 Debit Cards. These include operator services, busy line verification service, interruption service, calls requiring time and charges, air-to-ground calls, marine/satellite calls, and calls placed via dialing a 700 or 900 number. A Customer is entitled to a refund for the value of his or her card balance at any time upon return of the Prepaid Local Access Number Card or 800 Debit Card. In the event of the Company's financial failure, the Customer will be able to get refund information by calling the Company's toll-free customer service number.

Rates, terms, and conditions will be disclosed at the point of purchase by Customer.

#### 3.5.2 <u>800/888 Service (Toll free)</u>

This service is a direct access, incoming only, usage sensitive WATS offering. This is a service whereby a Customer can be billed at reduced rates for calls to his premises. This service is available to Customers located in Southwestern Bell Telephone Company territory only. All 800/888 service calls are measured in six (6) seconds initial and six (6) second additional increments.

#### 3.5.8 <u>1+ Dialing</u>

The customer utilizes "1+" dialing, or "1010XXX" dialing followed by "1+ ten digits" for interLATA calls, or dials "1010XXX" followed by "1+ 7 digits" or "1+ 10 digits" for intraLATA calls.

#### 3.5.9 Postpaid Calling Cards

The Company offers Postpaid Calling Cards, as indicated below, to all Customers presubscribed to Company's Services.

Calls are billed in one (1) minute initial and one (1) minute additional increments. Calls are billed on monthly long distance bill.

- (1) Dialing 1-888-XXX-XXXX;
- (2) At the chime, entering 10 digit home phone number + PIN, and
- (3) U.S. Calls: Dialing area code + number International calls: Dialing 011+Country code + city code + number.
