1 current balance of \$2,109.28 under the wireless termination tariff. CMT Partners and
2 Ameritech have made no payments under the access tariff.

3 **Q. Did Alma attempt to have the uncompensated traffic stopped?**

4 A. Yes. Under the wireless terminating tariff, Alma was authorized to have SWBT
5 prevent the inappropriate traffic from terminating. Alma made this request of SWBT.
6 SWBT informed Alma that SWBT would charge Alma \$1000.00 for this service. Alma
7 decided not to pay this amount. SWBT was not to have delivered this traffic in the
8 absence of an interconnection agreement, of which there is none. Alma went to the
9 expense of having its wireless terminating tariff approved in order to receive
10 compensation, but that did not work. As the price SWBT quoted amounted to three to
11 four months worth of total terminating wireless traffic, Alma decided that amount was
12 too much to pay.

13 **Q. Please set forth the amounts that Alma is owed for such traffic terminated**
14 **prior to the effective date of its Wireless Termination Tariff?**

15 A. The following list sets forth the amounts owed Alma by carriers who have
16 terminated traffic between February of 1998 and February of 2001 on Alma's network
