**ORDER CLOSING WORKSHOP**

On January 17, 2015, the Commission issued an order approving a Stipulation and Agreement in File No. SR-2014-0247. The agreement - entered into by Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. ("Central Rivers"), the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel – stipulated that tariff issues associated with the performance of Septic Tank Effluent Gravity ("STEG") and Septic Tank Effluent Pump ("STEP") installations for Central Rivers' customers was to be addressed in a workgroup set up by the Commission. The Commission opened a workgroup in which the parties in File No. SR-2014-0247 participated.

On November 4, Staff filed a request to close the working file, stating that Central Rivers, Staff, and OPC had addressed the STEP and STEG installation issues and that a new tariff went into effect on September 6. Staff states that the working group completed its directive, and no further action needs to be taken. No responses to Staff's filing were received. The Commission will close this working file.
