ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On January 29, 2007, ABA Net, LLC, applied for a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service. Along with its application, ABA Net filed a proposed tariff with the earliest effective date, 45 days after the tariff's issue date, allowed by Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.510(1)(C) ("45-day tariff"). The 45-day tariff was assigned tariff file number YX-2007-0530. On January 30, 2007, the Commission sent notice regarding the application, and provided an opportunity for interested parties to intervene on or before February 14, 2007.

On February 1, 2007, ABA Net filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment and a new tariff with an effective date of March 1st ("March 1st tariff"), which is less than 30 days from that tariff's issue date. In its motion ABA Net explains that its market potential will be adversely affected unless it can provide services to Missouri customers on March 1, 2007, or shortly thereafter. ABA Net also states its belief that its prospective customers will suffer no harm if its application and tariff are given expedited treatment. On February 2, 2007, ABA Net advised the Commission that it was withdrawing the March 1st tariff.

The Commission will order its Staff to file its recommendation concerning ABA Net's application and 45-day tariff on or before February 16, 2007.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its Recommendation in this case on or before February 16, 2007.
2. This order shall become effective on February 2, 2007.
