ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Issue Date: February 10, 2009

Effective Date: February 10, 2009

On February 9, 2009, the Commission's Staff filed a motion for an extension of time to file its recommendation regarding iNetworks Group, Inc.'s ("iNetworks") application for a certificate of service authority to provide certain telecommunications services in Missouri. Staff states that iNetworks' application is deficient because of missing financial information that is required pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.510. Staff has requested an extension of time until February 17, 2009 to file its recommendation.

The Commission finds Staff's request to be reasonable and shall grant it. However, iNetworks has also filed tariffs in conjunction with its application. Those tariffs bear an effective date of February 22, 2009. In order for Staff to obtain the information it needs prior to completing its recommendation, and in order for the Commission to have sufficient time to evaluate iNetworks application and Staff's recommendation once it is complete, and in order for the effective date of any order potentially approving the tariffs to be set at a sufficient interval to allow other parties to respond, the Commission may be required to suspend the tariffs.

Consequently, the Commission shall direct its Staff to file a status report no later than February 13, 2009 to advise the Commission if the tariffs will require suspension.

Should iNetworks voluntarily extend the effective date of its tariffs prior to February 13, 2009, then Staff will not be required to file a status report.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.
2. No later than February 17, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall its recommendation.
3. No later than February 13, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a status report advising the Commission if iNetworks Group, Inc.'s will require suspension. Should iNetworks Group, Inc. voluntarily extend the effective date of its tariffs, the requirement for a status report will be cancelled.
4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
