ORDER GRANTING STAFF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On October 26, 2011¹, Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation (CV Telecom) applied for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) throughout the exchange of Macon, Missouri served by Spectra Communication Group, LLP. The Commission ordered its Staff to file a Recommendation no later than December 28.

On December 29, Staff filed its Request for Extension of Time, Request for Continuance and Status Report. Staff explains that on November 18, the Federal Communications Commission changed the carrier criteria for the federal Universal Service Fund. Staff asks for a six-month continuance so that the FCC can clarify the new rules to CV Telecom about what support it may be eligible to receive. Accordingly, Staff also asks that the Commission indefinitely suspend the date for responses to Staff's Data Request.

The Commission finds Staff's requests reasonable, and will grant them.
