ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On March 11, 2014, Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. filed a request with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking approval of an increase in its annual sewer system operating revenues pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050. On October 10, 2014, the Office of the Public Counsel objected to a partial disposition agreement and requested a local public hearing and evidentiary hearing.

The Commission finds that a prehearing conference is now appropriate. Notice of the conference to the parties is being given in less time than the Commission's normal practice because of the short amount of time remaining to resolve this matter. The parties or their representatives shall appear in person, or by telephone, at the conference. Parties wishing to appear by telephone will be provided with a telephone conference number. At the conference, parties should be prepared to discuss the elements of a joint procedural schedule, including the dates for an evidentiary hearing and post-hearing briefs. The parties will also be encouraged to discuss settlement.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A prehearing conference shall be held on Wednesday October 22, 2014, beginning at 1:30 p.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This meeting will be held in a building that meets accessibility
