ORDER SETTING VIRTUAL HEARING AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE FOR COLLECTING PUBLIC COMMENT

On April 23, 2021, Mid MO Sanitation LLC (Mid MO) filed a notice requesting an increase in its annual overall operating revenues in a staff assisted sewer rate case. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.075(6) requires a local public hearing.

On May 24, 2021, Mid MO filed its customer notice which it sent to its customers on May 13, 2021. That notice set a virtual local public hearing for Thursday, June 3, 2021, beginning at 6:00 p.m. Because of the limitations imposed on public gatherings in response to COVID-19, the notice submitted to the Commission proposes the Commission conduct a virtual public hearing and collect written comments.

Based on the submitted hearing information, the Commission will now establish a date and procedure for the virtual public hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. A public hearing is scheduled to begin at **6 p.m.** on **June 3, 2021**, via the internet-based video and teleconferencing service, WebEx. WebEx details will be emailed to counsel separate from this order.

2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the

beginning of the local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question and answer session.

3. Mid MO, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer sessions. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.

4. To facilitate an orderly presentation that can be preserved for the record, members of the public who wish to participate in the hearing shall register by sending their first and last name, and whether connection will be via internet or by phone to watersewercomments@psc.mo.gov, or by calling (800) 392-4211 no later than 5:00 p.m. the day before the hearing, June 2, 2021. Details to access the hearing will be provided upon confirmation of registration.

5. A live audio web stream at the Commission's website, www.psc.mo.gov, will provide audio of the hearing. Those who do not intend to participate in the hearing should listen via the web stream.
