### ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On June 13, 2018, PowerComm Broadband, LLC (PowerComm), filed a Second Amended Application for registration, pursuant to Section 392.550 and Subsection 392.611.4, RSMo, to provide basic local telecommunications service, interexchange telecommunications service and interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) service in exchanges statewide in the state of Missouri. On June 15, 2018, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation regarding the application.

Staff recommended that the Commission grant PowerComm's registration for interexchange, non-switched local telecommunications service, and iVoIP service. However, with regard to basic local telecommunications service, Staff stated that the Commission should direct PowerComm "to file a tariff with the Commission or maintain a website which identifies the rates charged to each of its customer classes" and provide that website to the Commission Staff Director. Such a reference to a website would be in compliance with Section 392.461, RSMo. The Commission will direct its Staff to clarify its recommendation to clearly state whether it recommends that the Commission register or grant a certificate to PowerComm for the provision of basic local service, or whether it recommends that registration or certificate not be granted until

PowerComm complies with filing a tariff or notifying the Commission of a publically accessible website where its "generally available retail prices for . . .services" is available to the public.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall clarify its recommendation no later than June 26, 2018.
  - 2. This order is effective when issued.
