**SECOND ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE DISPOSITION AGREEMENT**

On March 11, 2014, Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. ("Central Rivers") filed a request with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking approval of an increase in its annual sewer system operating revenues pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050. Under subsection 11 of that rule, the Commission's Staff is required to file a disposition agreement providing for a full or partial resolution of Central Rivers' rate increase request no later than August 8, 2014. On August 6, 2014, Staff filed a motion requesting a 30-day extension of time in which to file the disposition agreement, which was subsequently granted by the Commission. On September 4, 2014, Staff requested a second 30-day extension of time. Staff represents that Central Rivers agrees with the request for an additional extension of time.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050(12) provides that Staff and Central Rivers may agree that the deadline to file a disposition agreement be extended for up to two months. The Commission concludes that Staff's motion meets the requirements of the rule, and the relief requested is reasonable. Therefore, the Commission will extend the time for Staff to file the disposition agreement until October 7, 2014.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The deadline for Staff to file the disposition agreement required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050(11) is extended until no later than October 7, 2014.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
