NOTICE OF CONTESTED CASE AND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On April 14, 2016, the Commission's Staff filed the *Motion for Provisional Revocation of the ETC Designation of Total Call Mobile, Inc. and Request for Order to Show Cause Why the Designation Should Not Be Permanently Revoked*, a copy of which is attached. That filing constitutes a complaint, which requires the Commission to set a hearing.¹ The requirement of a hearing on such issues signifies a contested case.² A contested case is a formal hearing procedure, but it allows for waiver of procedural formalities and a decision without an evidentiary hearing, including by stipulation and agreement.³ The Commission's regulations provide for discovery at 4 CSR 240-2.090.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following filings are ordered no later than May 16, 2016:
 - a. The respondent shall file an answer. The answer shall, in addition to the other requirements for an answer under the Commission's rules, show cause why the Commission should not recommend, to the Federal Communications

Commission and the Universal Service Administrative Company, that Total Call Mobile, Inc.'s federal funding be provisionally suspended; and

- b. Staff shall file a draft order recommending, to the Federal Communications Commission and the Universal Service Administrative Company, that Total Call Mobile, Inc.'s federal funding be provisionally suspended.
2. The commission's data center shall serve a copy of this order and the complaint upon the respondent, by certified mail, postage prepaid.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
