MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND TARIFF

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission open a case and cancel US Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Sprint Services' certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri, as well as its tariff. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On July 3, 1990, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services to US Telecom, Inc. in Case No. TA-90-127, under the fictitious name "Sprint Services." The Commission also approved the company's tariff, P.S.C. MO TARIFF No. 1 in that case.
- 2. For many years, US Telecom, Inc. did not appear on the Commission's list of certificated companies. Accordingly, the Commission did not send any information to the company, such as annual reports or statements of revenue. The company's tariff did not appear in the Commission's electronic filing and information system until they were discovered recently and entered into the system, and the company's name was re-entered and reactivated at that time as well.
- 3. Subsequently, Staff of the Commission received a request from Ken Schifman, Director, State Regulatory Affairs, a representative of US Telecom, Inc., to cancel the company's certificate. See Appendix A.

- 4. No formal complaints have been filed against the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System.
- 5. The web site of the Office of the Missouri Secretary of State reports that US Telecom, Inc. is a Kansas corporation in good standing in Missouri.
- 6. Because US Telecom, Inc. has requested cancellation of its certificate and because it is not providing telecommunications service in Missouri, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling the company's certificate.
- 7. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

8. This pleading is being served on the address provided by the company to the Commission via certified mail, as well as to its registered agent.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of US Telecom, Inc. d/b/a Sprint Services to provide intrastate interexchange services in Missouri, as well as its tariff, P.S.C. TARIFF MO No. 1.
