be raised and resolved without consuming hearing time.

1. Paragraphs 3L and 3M of the Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other

other provisions of the procedural schedule remain in effect.

However, when those documents are offered during the hearing, they will be assigned a number from that party's number group. 4. This order shall become effective when issued.
