The mediator can not be compelled to disclose any information disclosed during the mediation. Additionally, the mediation proceedings shall be regarded as settlement

negotiations. Any communication made during the process, not otherwise discoverable, shall be confidential and not admissible as evidence.

The mediator will not disclose any communication made during the mediation except as consented to by both parties or required by law.

Although many mediators charge an hourly rate for conducting mediations, there is no charge for mediations conducted for cases under the jurisdiction of the Missouri Public Service Commission.
