Scheduling a Hearing**

The Missouri Public Service Commission sets a date for an evidentiary hearing on the complaint as follows.

By order dated and effective on December 4, 2008, the Commission set the deadline for filing conflict dates and any motion for telephone testimony at December 11, 2008. On December 11, 2008, House Springs Sewer Company and the Commission's staff filed their responses. After a letter reminding the Scrivners of the need to respond to Commission orders, Michael Scrivner made a response by email on December 18, 2008.

Michael Scrivner's response states:

I apologize for not responding to the first letter but the way I understood it I only needed to respond if I had any conflicts with potential dates. I do not have any conflicts and can attend the hearing whenever the date and time are set. Thanks

1. The Commission extends the filing deadline for Michael Scrivner’s response to the Commission’s order issued and effective on December 4, 2008.
2. The hearing on the complaint shall convene at 10:00 a.m., on January 30, 2009, in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri.
3. The hearing room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
