STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant approval of the Interconnection Agreement between Universal Telecom, Inc. and ALLTEL Communications Service Corporation filed on December 11, 2000, as supplemented by filings made on January 2, 2001, and January 9, 2001.
- 2. The terms of the interconnection agreement do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity. Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e), the Commission is to approve a negotiated interconnection agreement unless the terms of the agreement discriminate against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the Agreement or implementation of the

agreement or any portion thereof is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

- 3. In addition to approving the agreement, because the agreement submitted does not have pages numbered consecutively in the lower right-hand corner, the Staff recommends the Commission direct the parties to submit a copy of the interconnection agreement with the pages numbered consecutively in the lower right-hand corner for filing in the Commission's tariff room.
- 4. The Staff also recommends that the Commission direct the parties to submit any modifications or amendments to the agreement to the Commission for review.

WHEREFORE, because the terms set forth in this agreement satisfy the standard set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252(e) in that they do not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and do not appear to be against the public interest, convenience, or necessity, the Staff recommends the Commission enter an Order Approving Interconnection Agreement.
