STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant Maverix.com, Inc. d/b/a Maverix.net (Applicant) a certificate of authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440, RSMo 1994.)
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See §392.361.2 RSMo 1994.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See §392.361.3 RSMo 1994.)
- 3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the Applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO NO. 1, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application. The

Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420, RSMo 1994 and § 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999.)

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant Maverix.com, Inc. d/b/a Maverix.net a certificate to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, grant Applicant competitive classification, approve Applicant's proposed tariff with a proposed effective date of March 10, 2000, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications.

A Notice of Deficiency was issued October 5, 1999. On October 8, 1999, Applicant filed a Filing to Satisfy Notice of Deficiency. The Filing to Satisfy Notice of Deficiency contained an error in the waiver list, in that 4 CSR 240-10.010(2) should have been 4 CSR 240-32.030(2), Records to be kept in-state. Also, 4 CSR 240-33.040(5), which was requested to be waived, was not included in the tariff. On February 4, 2000, Applicant filed an Amendment to Previous Filing to correct the errors. A substitute tariff sheet was attached to the Amendment. Applicant filed further substitute tariff sheets on February 10, 2000, at Staff's request. Staff has reviewed the substitute sheets and finds them acceptable.

On October 6, 1999, Applicant filed a notice of name change, i.e., Maverix.com d/b/a Maverix.net. Applicant requested expedited approval of the tariff. Staff has no objection to expedited approval.
