**SECOND ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Effective Date: August 25, 2016

The Commission established a procedural schedule in its *Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on June 24, 2016, and subsequently amended that schedule to extend the deadline for filing rebuttal testimony to August 25, 2016. On August 24, 2016 at 5:04 p.m., the Commission’s Staff; Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri; the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy; Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri; and Walmart Stores, Inc. (“Movants”) filed a joint motion to further amend the procedural schedule. Movants have requested more time to file rebuttal testimony and the extension of other filing deadlines because they are preparing a stipulation and agreement in which other parties may wish to join or address in rebuttal testimony. Movants have failed to state whether the other four non-moving parties to this matter object to their request, and there is not sufficient time for the Commission to obtain their responses to the joint motion as the deadline for rebuttal testimony is today. However, since Movants represent that they will soon be filing a stipulation and agreement, rebuttal testimony will be more informative and valuable to the

Commission if the non-moving parties have an opportunity to address that stipulation and agreement in their testimony. Therefore, the Commission will grant Movants' request to amend the procedural schedule.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Staff; Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri; the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy; Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri; and Walmart Stores, Inc.'s *Joint Motion to Modify Procedural Schedule* filed on August 24, 2016, is granted.

2. The procedural schedule is amended, as follows:

<b>Date</b>	<b>Event</b>
Aug. 31, 2016	Rebuttal testimony by non-company parties
Aug. 31, 2016	Data request response time shortened to 10 days (5 business days to object/give notice of need for more time)
Sept. 23, 2016	Surrebuttal testimony
Sept. 23, 2016	Data request response time shortened to 5 days (2 business days to object/give notice of need for more time)
Oct. 3, 2016	Last day to request discovery
Oct. 5, 2016	Joint list of issues, order of witnesses, order of parties for cross-examination, order of opening statements
Oct. 7, 2016	Position statements

3. All other provisions of the Commission's *Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Other Procedural Requirements* issued on June 24, 2016, shall remain unchanged.

4. This order shall be effective when issued.
