STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant approval of an Interconnection Agreement between AT&T Wireless Services, Inc., and ALLTEL Communications Corporation. The Commission shall approve such agreements under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 unless it finds that the agreement discriminates against a nonparty telecommunications carrier or it finds that the implementation of the agreement is inconsistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission approve the Interconnection Agreement between the parties of this case, and order the parties to submit a copy of the Interconnection Agreement numbered sequentially.
