COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) approve the adoption of the GTE / AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. Interconnection Agreement by Teleport Communications Group, Inc. / TCG St. Louis and TCG Kansas City, Inc.
- 2. The GTE / AT&T Communications of the Southwest, Inc. Interconnection Agreement received Commission approval in Case No. TO-97-63 effective August 4, 1998.
- 3. The Commission's authority to approve or reject this adoption of a previously approved Interconnection Agreement is pursuant to 47 U.S.C. section 252(e) and 252(i) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 4. The Staff concludes that the adoption of the Interconnection Agreement does not appear to discriminate against telecommunications carriers not a party to the Agreement and the Agreement does not appear to be against the public interest, convenience or necessity.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends approval of the adoption of the Interconnection Agreement.
