ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Socket Telecom, LLC, has filed a complaint against MCI Communications Services, Inc., d/b/a Verizon Business Services, regarding compensation for telecommunications traffic. On October 23, Verizon filed a motion asking the Commission to dismiss the complaint for lack of jurisdiction. On November 1, Socket filed a response to Verizon's motion in which it indicates that the parties have been able to resolve much of their dispute. As a result, Socket agrees that the Commission should dismiss its complaint.

Based upon the agreement of the complainant and the respondent that this complaint should be dismissed, the Commission will dismiss the complaint.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Socket Telecom, LLC's complaint against MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services is dismissed.
