ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: January 5, 2006 Effective Date: January 12, 2006 On December 30, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a motion asking the Commission to cancel the certificates of service authority and accompanying tariff of U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications, a company that has been authorized to offer basic local, local exchange, and interexchange telecommunications services by the Commission.

In Case Number TA-2000-732, the Commission granted TelePacific Communications a certificate to provide basic local and local exchange services. TelePacific Communications never filed a tariff to provide those services. As a result, the company's certificate of service authority never came into effect, although the Commission's system reflects its certificate as "active" and the company has submitted annual reports and statements of revenue. In Case Number TA-2000-731, the Commission granted TelePacific Communications a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange

telecommunications services and approved the company's interexchange tariff, P.S.C. MO. No. 1.

Staff's motion states that it has received a letter from the "Corporate Records Analyst" of TelePacific Communications indicating that it had no customers in the state of Missouri and did not intend to provide service to Missourians in the future. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services, interexchange telecommunications services, and its interexchange tariff, P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 1. TelePacific Communications has not responded to Staff's motion.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "any certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on Staff's motion, the statement of the certificate holder included in that motion, and on TelePacific Communications' failure to respond, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff granted to U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications, should be canceled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the certificates of authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services, interexchange telecommunications

services granted to U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications, in Case Numbers TA-2000-732 and TA-2000-731, are canceled.

2. That U.S. TelePacific Corp. d/b/a TelePacific Communications' tariff, P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 1, is cancelled.

- 3. That this order shall become effective on January 12, 2006.
- 4. That this case may be closed on January 13, 2006.
