MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFFS

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves the Commission to cancel Teligent Services, Inc.'s certificate of service authority to provide basic local services, as well as its tariffs, MoPSC No. 1 and P.S.C. MO. No. 3 (relating to basic local exchange service) and P.S.C. MO. Tariff No. 2 (relating to interexchange service). In support of its Motion, the Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. The Commission granted Teligent Services, Inc. a certificate of service authority to provide basic local and local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri in Case No. TA-2000-578, with an effective date of November 19, 2000. The Commission approved the company's tariff, Access Service Tariff No. 3 Missouri, in the same case. A business end user customers tariff, Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 2, was also approved.
- 2. The Commission also granted Teligent Services, Inc. a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services limited to providing dedicated, nonswitched local exchange private line services in Missouri in Case No. TA-2000-581, with an effective date of May 31, 2000. The Commission approved the company's tariff, Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 1, in the same case.

- 3. On January 25, 2005, the "Manager, Regulatory Affairs" of Teligent Services, Inc. sent a letter to the Commission requesting that the Commission cancel its certificates of service authority because it no longer had any Missouri customers. See Appendix A.
- 4. The letter attached as Appendix A references a transfer of assets, but as the company had no assets in Missouri at the time (i.e., no Missouri customers), the company did not require the Commission's approval. The Commission's records reflect that Teligent Services, Inc. has no active interconnection agreements.
- 5. No complaints against Teligent Services, Inc. regarding its telecommunications services have been filed with the Commission since the Commission's EFIS system began operation.
- 6. Teligent Services, Inc. remains in good standing at the Missouri Secretary of State. It filed its most recent annual registration report there on April 5, 2004. On June 3, 2005, the Secretary of State's Office sent the company a warning that it was delinquent in filing its annual registration report for the current year and that it could be administratively dissolved.
- 7. In keeping with the assertion that Teligent ceased to operate in Missouri in 2004, Teligent Services, Inc. has failed to submit its 2004 annual reports to the Commission that were due on April 15, 2005. It does not owe the Commission any assessments.
- 8. Accordingly, because Teligent Services, Inc. no longer has any Missouri customers and because it has requested cancellation of its certificates of service authority, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling Teligent Services, Inc.'s certificates of service authority to provide basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services and its tariffs, Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 2 and Access Service Tariff

- No. 3 Missouri (relating to basic local exchange service) and Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 1 (relating to interexchange service).
- 9. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

9. This pleading will be served via certified mail on the address provided by the company to the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel Teligent Services, Inc.'s certificates of service authority to provide basic local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services and its tariffs, Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 2 and Access Service Tariff No. 3 - Missouri (relating to basic local exchange service) and Tariff MO P.S.C. No. 1 (relating to interexchange service).
