ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 30, 2013, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri and several other organizations (collectively Renew Missouri) filed a complaint against Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri. The current procedural schedule for this case will lead to an evidentiary hearing on October 22, with a list of issues due to be filed on October 10.

On October 10, the parties filed a stipulation and agreement that would resolve Renew Missouri's complaint against Ameren Missouri. On the same day, the parties filed a joint motion asking the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule to eliminate the need to file additional documents and prepare for hearing while the Commission considers the stipulation and agreement.

Since a hearing regarding Renew Missouri's complaints against Ameren Missouri may not be necessary, the Commission will suspend the procedural schedule regarding that complaint.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule in File No. EC-2013-0381 is suspended.
2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
