NOTICE OF RULINGS MADE AT CONFERENCE

Issue Date: March 28, 2014

While on the record at the procedural conference held on March 28, 2014, the Presiding Officer made the following rulings from the bench:

1. The parties were ordered to file a proposed procedural schedule by April 1, 2014. If agreement can be reached, the parties may file a single proposed schedule. If the parties are unable to agree, they may file separate schedules for the Commission's consideration. Similarly, the parties may file a combined procedural schedule for the two

complaints, or they may file separate schedules if they believe separate schedules for the two complaints are appropriate.

2. Ameren Missouri made a motion requesting more time to reply to the responses filed on March 27 to that company's motions to dismiss both complaints. Ameren Missouri also requested oral argument regarding the motions to dismiss. The presiding officer allowed Ameren Missouri until April 15 to file its reply. No ruling was made on the request for oral argument. The presiding officer also indicated that the pendency of the motions to dismiss would not preclude further action by the Commission to establish a procedural schedule or any other action in these cases.
