APPLICATION FOR AN ORDER DIRECTING THE GENERAL COUNSEL TO PETITION THE CIRCUIT COURT OF COLE COUNTY FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A RECEIVER FOR ROGUE CREEK UTILITIES, INC., AND APPOINTING AN INTERIM RECEIVER

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and, for its Application for an Order Directing the General Counsel to Petition the Circuit Court of Cole County for the Appointment of a Receiver for Rogue Creek Utilities, Inc., and Appointing an Interim Receiver, states to the Missouri Public Service Commission as follows:

- 1. Rogue Creek Utilities, Inc. ("Rogue Creek" or "Company") is a Missouri general business corporation, which was administratively dissolved effective December 30, 2004 and is not in good standing. A true copy of the certificate of the Missouri Secretary of State is attached hereto as Exhibit A
- 2. William J. Rummel is the sole officer and director of Rogue Creek, and owns all of Rogue Creek's outstanding stock. A true copy of the Company's most recent Annual Registration Report, which was filed with the Missouri Secretary of State on August 25, 2003, is attached hereto as Exhibit B and incorporated herein by reference. Exhibit B shows that William J. Rummel is the sole officer and director of the Company. Also attached hereto, as Exhibit C, is

a true copy of the Affidavit of William J. Rummel, wherein Mr. Rummel states that he is the sole officer and director of Rogue Creek and that he owns all of the Company's outstanding stock.

- 3. Rogue Creek is a "public utility," a "water corporation," and a "sewer corporation," as those terms are defined in Section 386.020.¹ Rogue Creek regularly provides water and sewer service to fewer than eight thousand customers. According to available Commission records, Rogue Creek's principal place of business or corporate headquarters of record is in Washington County, Missouri, at: 10019 Simmental Lane, Potosi, MO 63664.
- 4. The Company has the duty, pursuant to Section 393.130, to provide safe and adequate service to its customers. Section 393.130.1 provides, in part, as follows:

Every gas corporation, every electrical corporation, every water corporation, and every sewer corporation shall furnish and provide such service instrumentalities and facilities as shall be safe and adequate and in all respects just and reasonable.

5. Section 393.145.1 authorizes the Commission to seek the appointment of a receiver for a water corporation or a sewer corporation in certain circumstances. It provides in full as follows:

If, after hearing, the commission determines that any sewer or water corporation that regularly provides service to eight thousand or fewer customer connections is unable or unwilling to provide safe and adequate service, has been actually or effectively abandoned by its owners, or has defaulted on a bond, note or loan issued or guaranteed by any department, office, commission, board, authority or other unit of state government, the commission may petition the circuit court for an order attaching the assets of the utility and placing the utility under the control and responsibility of a receiver. The venue for such cases shall, at the option of the commission, be in the circuit court of Cole County or in the circuit court of the county in which the utility company has its principal place of business.

6. William J. Rummel, the sole officer, director and shareholder of the Company is suffering from the effects of Alzheimer's Disease, in its early stages. His physical and mental limitations make it increasingly difficult for him to continue to manage Rogue Creek, and he is

no longer willing or able to devote a significant amount of time to the management of Rogue Creek. Mr. Rummel wants Rogue Creek to continue to provide safe and adequate water and sewer service to its customers, but does not wish to continue to own and operate the utility. Mr. Rummel has not identified any persons or entities available and ready to acquire and operate the assets, and he therefore requests that interim and permanent receivers be appointed for the Company, so that the assets of the Company can be sold. See the Affidavit of Mr. Rummel, which is attached hereto as Exhibit C.

- 7. Mr. Rummel capably operated Rogue Creek for many years, beginning in 1976, and the Company has provided safe and adequate water and sewer service to its customers. In recent years, Mr. Rummel has recognized that the effects of aging have made it difficult for him to personally provide the high quality of water and sewer service that he wants his customers to enjoy. He has therefore responsibly handed the day-to-day operation of the Company to Rita and Joe Coleman. He has now decided to consent to the appointment of interim and permanent receivers, to insure that Rogue Creek's customers continue to receive safe and adequate water and sewer service.
- 8. Rita and Joe Coleman have served well in their capacity as managers of Rogue Creek's facilities and operations. However, they do not have the authority to sell and transfer the Company's assets to a third party, and they lack the authority to take other actions that only the owners, officers, or directors of the Company can take.
- 9. The Company's conduct satisfies one of the statutory bases for the appointment of a receiver, in that Mr. Rummel, the sole officer, director, and shareholder of the Company, is unable to continue to devote sufficient time to operate the Company, and therefore the Company is now, or will soon be, unable to continue to provide safe and adequate service to its customers.

- 10. If the Commission determines, after hearing, that Rogue Creek is a sewer or water corporation that regularly provides service to 8,000 or fewer customers, and that it is unable to provide safe and adequate service to its customers, Section 393.145.1 authorizes the Commission to file a petition the Circuit Court of Cole County or the Circuit Court of Washington County for an order attaching the assets of the Company and placing the Company under the control and responsibility of a receiver.
- 11. If the Commission files a petition in the circuit court for the appointment of a receiver for Rogue Creek, Section 393.145.7 authorizes the Commission to request that the court find that control of, and responsibility for, the Company should not, in the best interests of its customers, be returned to its owner, and authorizes the circuit court to direct the receiver to transfer by sale or liquidate Rogue Creek's assets in the manner provided by law.
- 12. If the Commission orders its general counsel to petition the circuit court for the appointment of a receiver for Rogue Creek, Section 393.145.2 authorizes the Commission to appoint an interim receiver for the Company, who shall be compensated in an amount to be determined by the Commission, and who shall serve until the circuit court determines whether to grant the Commission's request for the appointment of a receiver.
- 13. Rita Coleman is a responsible person with knowledge in the operation of utilities generally, and with experience and knowledge regarding the operations of Rogue Creek in particular. The Staff recommends that the Commission appoint Rita Coleman as the interim receiver for Rogue Creek. The Staff further recommends that the Commission authorize the interim receiver to be compensated from Rogue Creek's assets in an amount to be determined by the Commission upon the recommendation of the Staff. The Staff also believes that Rita Coleman would be available to act as a manager for a permanent receiver, if such receiver so desires.

WHEREFORE, the Staff prays that the Commission issue its order finding that Rogue Creek is a water and sewer utility that regularly provides service to fewer than 8,000 customers; finding that Rogue Creek is now, or will soon be, unable to provide safe and adequate service to its customers; ordering the general counsel of the Commission to petition the Circuit Court of Cole County for an order attaching the assets of the Company and placing the Company under the control and responsibility of a receiver and for an order directing the appointed receiver to transfer by sale or to liquidate the assets of the Company in the manner provided by law; appointing Rita Coleman as the interim receiver of the Company pursuant to Section 393.145.2; and authorizing the interim receiver to be compensated from Rogue Creek's assets in an amount to be determined by the Commission.

AFFIDAVIT OF WILLIAM J. RUMMEL

UTILITY OPERATIONS

COMES NOW William J. Rummel and, being duly sworn on his oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am the owner of all of the outstanding stock of Rogue Creek Utilities, Inc. (RCU), an administratively dissolved Missouri corporation. I have owned all of the outstanding stock of RCU from the time of its incorporation on December 9, 1974 until the present time. I am also the sole officer and director of RCU.
- 2. RCU is a public utility regulated by the Missouri Public Service Commission, and is a "water corporation" and "sewer corporation," as defined by Section 386.020, RSMo. RCU holds certificates of convenience and necessity from the Public Service Commission to provide water and sewer service, and currently provides service to approximately 115 water customers and 100 sewer customers in its certificated service territory near Potosi, Missouri.
- 3. RCU has provided safe and adequate service to its customers from the date of the granting of its certificates of convenience and necessity in 1976, which were granted in Case No. -18,758, to the present, with the exception of a time between November 1, 1983 and October 6, 1988 when the assets were sold, as authorized in Case No. WM-83-328, and subsequently reacquired by foreclosure. RCU continues to provide safe and adequate service to its customers.
- 4. I have been, and continue to be, responsible for the overall management of RCU. However, earlier this year I turned over the responsibility for the day-to-day operation of RCU to Rita Coleman, who has capably worked for RCU or has been involved in its operations for the past six (6) years.

- 5. I am years old, and my doctors have informed me that I am in the early stages of Alzheimer's Disease. My physical and mental limitations make it increasingly difficult for me to continue to manage RCU, and I am no longer willing to devote a significant amount of time to the management of RCU.
- 6. I want to insure that the customers of RCU continue to receive safe and adequate water and sewer service, either through new ownership and management of RCU, or through transfer of the assets of RCU to another entity.
- 7. The members of my family do not wish to continue to operate RCU, and I have not been able to identify any other person or entity that wants to buy the stock or assets of RCU.
- 8. I recommend to the Missouri Public Service Commission that Rita Coleman be named as the interim receiver for RCU, to manage and operate the utility until a receiver can be appointed for RCU pursuant to the provisions of Section 393.145, RSMo.
