## ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING AND SUSPENDING TARIFF

Issue Date: April 9, 2013 Effective Date: April 9, 2013

On November 2, 2012, Gladlo Water & Sewer Company, Inc., through its court-appointed receiver, Heartland Utilities, LLC, initiated small company rate increase proceedings for its water and sewer services.

On April 3, 2013, the Staff of the Commission filed a notice that it and the company entered into an agreement for an increase of \$9,690 in operating revenues for its sewer system and an increase of \$4,749 for its water service. On April 8, 2013, the company filed tariffs reflecting the agreement. The tariffs bears an effective date of May 24, 2013, with increases from \$18.42 to \$31.66 in sewer service and an average increase in water service from \$27.06 to \$34.32.

The Office of the Public Counsel did not join in the agreement but instead filed a request for a local public hearing. Public Counsel states that a critical part of the ratemaking process is affording customers an opportunity to speak to the Commission; specifying, that this is particularly so given the significance of the increase during the current economic times.

Public Counsel points out that Commission rules<sup>1</sup> require the company to send notice to its customers of the proposed rate increase within 5 days of the tariff filing. If a public hearing is held, the company must send an additional notice to its customers. Public Counsel therefore requests that the Commission waive the 5-day notice requirement for the tariff filing and direct the company to send a combined notice instead.

The Commission has reviewed Public Counsel's request and finding it reasonable will suspend the tariff, set by separate order a local public hearing, and waive the company's obligation to within 5 days notify customers of the proposed tariff filing.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Office of the Public Counsel's request for a local public hearing is granted.
- 2. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-3.050(14) is waived and the company need not, within 5 days, send notice to its customers of the proposed tariff.
- 3. The following tariff, filed by Gladlo Water & Sewer Company, Inc. and assigned Tariff File No. YS-2013-0431, is suspended until September 21, 2013 or until otherwise ordered by the Commission:
