ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On October 29, 2014, Peaceful Valley Service Company ("Peaceful Valley") submitted replacement tariffs (Tracking Nos. YS-2015-0185 and YW-2015-0186). Peaceful Valley indicates the replacement tariffs are intended to comply with the rates approved by the Commission in its October 8, 2014 Report and Order. The tariff sheets have a November 28, 2014 effective date. Peaceful Valley requests the Commission approve the replacement tariffs in an expedited manner. The Commission directed the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation on the tariff sheets and set a deadline for objections to the tariff sheets. On October 30, 2014, Staff filed a recommendation stating the tariffs are compliant with the Commission's Report and Order. Staff recommended the Commission approve the tariffs and also act expeditiously, as requested by Peaceful Valley.

The Commission will set a deadline for responses to Staff's recommendations to approve the tariff sheets and to grant Peaceful Valley's request for expedited treatment.

- 1. Objections to Peaceful Valley Service Company's replacement tariff sheets or responses to Staff's recommendation to approve the tariff sheet and grant the request for expedited treatment shall be filed no later than November 10, 2014.
