Staff Recommendation to Approve the Transfer of Assets from USTel, Inc. and Arcada

Communications, Inc. to OneStar Long Distance, Inc.

On January 12, 2000, OneStar Long Distance, Inc., (OneStar), a competitive interexchange telecommunications company, filed an application for the approval of the purchase of the USTel, Inc. (USTel) and Arcada Communications, Inc. (in Missouri as, S.V.V Sales, Inc., d/b/a Arcada Communications) assets. The assets included the long distance customer base, Arcada wireless/cellular customer accounts, equipment, names, deposits and refunds, franchises, permits, licenses, authorizations, books and records. The only asset purchased in Missouri however, was the long distance customer base (227 active customers).

Arcada Communications, Inc. (Arcada) is a subsidiary of USTel; the cases were combined in bankruptcy court and are combined for the purpose of this case, TM-2000-419. Also on January 12, 2000, OneStar submitted direct testimony of Laura Collier, OneStar regulatory supervisor, to supplement the application.

OneStar was granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in Case TA-98-50. On March 10, 1999, USTel and Arcada filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy with the United States Bankruptcy Court of the Western District of Washington (Docket No 99-02632). In connection with its plan for relief under Chapter 11, USTel and Arcada solicited offers for its telecommunications assets, and OneStar responded. The parties reached an agreement whereby USTel and Arcada would sell its assets, including its long distance customer base. This agreement was approved by the Bankruptcy Court on July 13, 1999.

OneStar updated its tariff to provide service for USTel and Arcada customers under the same terms and conditions provided by USTel and Arcada. There were 227 active USTel and Arcada customers in Missouri and OneStar reports that there was no detrimental impact on customers as a result of this transaction. OneStar notified customers of the transition by letter (attached to application) and reports no complaints from customers since the transition.

OneStar states that there are no final judgments against it from any state or federal agency and states that it will be providing the services for USTel and Arcada customers under OneStar's current tariff (which has been updated to offer USTel and Arcada customers similar rate plans).

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has reviewed the application for the transfer of assets and has no objections to the proposed transaction. The Company asked for the transfer to be approved *nunc pro tunc*. However, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order to approve the transfer of USTel and Arcada's Dial 1+ Customer Base to OneStar, *prospectively*. The Staff is unaware of any filing that affects or would be affected by this transfer.
