**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On March 24, 2005, Matrix Telecom, Inc., Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., and Global Crossing Telemangement, Inc. (jointly referred to as the applicants) filed an application requesting approval of a transaction in which Matrix would acquire certain assets of the Global Crossing companies. The applicants requested approval by the Commission by May 15, 2005.

On April 1, 2005, the Commission's Staff filed its Status Report, noting that because Matrix does not have a certificate of service authority to provide customers with basic local telecommunications service, Staff is unable to state a specific date on which it will be able to file its recommendation. Staff also indicated that it anticipates that Matrix will soon file an application for authority to provide basic local telecommunications service.

Staff filed its Second Status Report on May 27, 2005. Staff noted that it has been working with Matrix on revising its proposed basic local tariff. Staff also noted that Matrix has not yet filed an interconnection agreement. Moreover, Staff indicated that before it can recommend approval of the proposed transfer of basic local customers, Matrix

will need a basic local certificate, a basic local tariff, and an approved interconnection agreement. The Commission subsequently directed Matrix and the Global Crossing companies to file a supplemental pleading address the status of the proposed transfer of assets.

On June 23, 2005, Matrix and the Global Crossing companies filed a Supplemental Pleading in which they concur with the Staff's status reports filed on April 1, 2005, and May 27, 2005. The applicants state that the transaction proposed in its application is not complete. The applicants also note that Matrix filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service, along with a proposed basic local tariff, on April 29, 2005. Although Matrix has not yet filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement, it intends to do so in the near future.

The Commission will direct Matrix and the Global Crossing companies to file an additional status report regarding the progress of this case and of the related application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service. The applicants should also indicate whether they have filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That no later than July 25, 2005, Matrix Telecom, Inc., Global Crossing Telecommunications, Inc., Global Crossing Local Services, Inc., and Global Crossing Telemanagement, Inc., shall file a status report as directed above.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 1, 2005.
