ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR FILING OF RESPONSES TO STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

On September 15, 2015, Southtown Utilities Company, Inc. (“Southtown”) filed applications with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking authority to sell and transfer its sewer and water utilities to the City of Bolivar, Missouri (“Bolivar”).

The Commission issued an order directing the Commission's Staff to file a recommendation on Southtown's applications. On October 19, Staff filed a recommendation that the Commission expeditiously approve the sale of Southtown to Bolivar, subject to certain conditions. Staff also recommends the Commission cancel Southtown's Certificates of Convenience and Necessity and tariffs once the transfers are complete.

The Commission will set a deadline for responses to Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Responses to Staff's Recommendation may be filed no later than October 23, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
