## ORDER De-Classifying Staff Report

The Commission grants the Commission's staff's motion to de-classify the investigative report filed by Staff. Staff filed the report and the motion on August 1, 2008. On October 15, 2008, the Commission re-assigned this case to the current presiding officer.
