The Missouri Public Service Commission grants the motion for an extension of time ("motion") filed by ALEC, Inc. ("ALEC"). ALEC filed the motion on January 6, 2009, seeking an extension of the time for the Commission's staff ("Staff") to file its recommendation until January 31, 2009. In support, ALEC states that it has not completed its discussions of supplementary information with Staff. Staff has no objection to the motion, according to ALEC. Therefore, the Commission will grant the order.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file its recommendation as to ALEC's application no later than January 31, 2009.
