## ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE

Issue Date: June 19, 2015

Effective Date: June 29, 2015

On June 3, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Illinois Payphone Systems, Inc. ("Illinois Payphone Systems") certificate of service authority to provide payphone telecommunication services in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number TA-2000-420, the Commission granted Illinois Payphone Systems a certificate of service authority to provide payphone telecommunication service in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that Illinois Payphone Systems contacted Staff via the company's Statement of Revenue for the FY-2016 Mo PSC Assessment and informed Staff that Illinois Payphone Systems no longer wished to provide service in Missouri. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's certificate of service authority to provide payphone telecommunications services.

On June 4, 2015, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than June 15, 2015. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.


The Commission has the authority to cancel a certificate and tariff pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, “[a]ny certificate or service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.”

Based on Staff’s motion, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to Illinois Payphone Systems, Inc., shall be canceled.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The certificate of authority to provide payphone telecommunications services granted to Illinois Payphone Systems, Inc., in File Number TA-2000-420, is canceled.
2. This order shall become effective on June 29, 2015.
3. This case may be closed on June 30, 2015.
