The Missouri Public Service Commission grants the motion for an extension of time ("motion") filed by ALEC, Inc. ("ALEC"). ALEC filed the motion on January 21, 2009, stating that its discussions of supplementary information with the Commission's staff ("Staff") are complete, but Staff now seeks financial information through January 2009, which ALEC can provide no sooner than February 15, 2009. ALEC seeks an extension of the time for Staff to file its recommendation until March 31, 2009. Staff has no objection to the motion, according to ALEC. Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.<sup>1</sup>

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file its recommendation as to ALEC's application no later than March 31, 2009.
