The Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) opened Case No. WW-2009-0386, *In the Matter of a Working Case to Investigate Solutions to Problems Facing Small Water and Sewer Public Utilities*, to specifically receive company, customer, and interested stakeholder insight and comments about small water and sewer utility's regulatory processes. In conjunction with this case, the Commission hosted a Water Symposium on June 5, 2009. Many of the regulated water and sewer companies participated in person or watched the presentations via the Commission's webcast of that event.

On Thursday, October 1, 2009, Staff hosted an open forum to discuss issues impacting small water and sewer utilities in the State of Missouri. About 40 people showed up to discuss various issues impacting those industries. Attendees expressed interested in participating in additional open forums.
