The parties submitted the proposed Agreement to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) pursuant to the terms of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act), USCOC of Greater Missouri, LLC, d/b/a/ U.S. Cellular ("US Cellular") failed to include certificate of service indicating that the pleading was served on the General Counsel of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel. After being ordered to provide this documentation by the Commission on May 25, 2005, U.S. Cellular filed the certificate of service the following day, May 26, 2005.

Staff has reviewed the proposed Agreement and notes that the agreement includes terms, conditions, and rates for the transiting of traffic to and from a third-party provider that is not a party to the agreement. Staff believes the proposed Agreement meets the limited requirements of the Act. Specifically, the Agreement: 1) does not discriminate against telecommunications carriers not party to the Agreement and 2) is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
