### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On May 9, 2007, Aurora Communications, Inc. filed an application with the Commission for approval of an interconnection agreement with AT&T Missouri under the provisions of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 2. Section 252(e) of the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 provides that a State commission may only reject a negotiated agreement if it finds that the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. 47 U.S.C. §252(e).
- 3. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff states that the interconnection agreement does not discriminate against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement and is not against the public interest, convenience or necessity.
- 4. Staff notes that the applicants have not submitted a serially numbered copy of the Agreement. Therefore, Staff recommends the Commission direct the Parties to submit a serially numbered copy of the Agreement.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission approve the interconnection agreement pursuant to the Act, and direct the parties to submit a serially numbered copy of the

Agreement. Further, Staff recommends the Commission direct the parties to submit any modifications or amendments to the Agreement to the Commission for approval.
