**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO FILE MEMORANDUM**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and for its motion states:

1. On October 4, 2005, Neutral Tandem-Missouri, LLC filed an application for approval of an interconnection agreement with Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P. d/b/a SBC Missouri.

2. On October 5, 2005, the Commission issued an order joining SBC Missouri as a party and directing the Staff to file a memorandum advising either approval or rejection of this agreement and giving the reasons therefore no later than November 7, 2005.

3. The Staff is discussing with Neutral Tandem-Missouri the absence of a transiting traffic provision in the agreement.

4. The Staff notes that Neutral Tandem-Missouri has not yet received a basic local certificate and has not yet filed a proposed basic local tariff. See Case No. CA-2006-0035.

5. The Staff requests an extension to November 17, 2005, to file its memorandum in this case. The Staff has been authorized to state that Neutral Tandem-Missouri does not object to the requested extension.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.050(3), an extension of time until November 17, 2005, to file its memorandum in this case.
