**ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE TARIFF**

On October 6, 1998, the Commission issued an order which granted Suretel, Inc. (Suretel) a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services. The order required Suretel to file tariff sheets reflecting the rates, rules, regulations and the services it will offer within 30 days after October 16, the effective date of the order.

On November 10, Suretel filed a Request for Additional Time to File Tariff in which it requested an additional thirty days in which to file its tariff.

The Commission finds that Suretel's request is reasonable.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That Suretel, Inc.'s Request for Additional Time to File Tariff is granted.

2. That Suretel, Inc. shall file its tariff sheets reflecting the rates, rules, regulations and the services it will offer, no later than December 16, 1998.

3. That this order shall become effective on November 30, 1998.
